NORFOLK

ISLAND and its bowlers.

Norfolk is a self-governing territory of Australia with a fascinating history marked by romance, adventure, discovery, darkness and light. Its regional history is uniquely marked by its place on the great Polynesian migration route and the discovery track of the great navigator Capt. James Cook; the infamy and gloom as a remote British penal colony and the promise of survival at the end of a long journey by the descendants of the Bounty mutineers. The Islanders are great sports-persons with fierce and competitive bowlers who lie in wait at their clubhouse for the Aussies and Kiwis to challenge them at their games. They are good losers (which is not a regular occurrence) and will accept your commiserations in return for a beer. Join them at the bowlo situated in the heart of the business district well within walking distance of most accommodation and retail outlets. Norfolk's weather is year-round balmy and sub-tropical and lends itself to outdoor sports. **The Feb '15 South Pacific Pairs** is a growing event in the shadow of the high-season hubbub timed to keep prices low and enthusiasm high. Relax at summers end in balmy 24 degree warmth and over 7 hours of sunshine. The only things that beat the weather are the bowls, the friendliness and the value offered by Heritage Events. This is a 6-day open pairs event attracting visitors from the Australian mainland and New Zealand. Women can line up to the men...often with alarming outcomes. **Bounty Bowls** It's early May now the end of Spring and the weather remains, well....pretty springy. We beat Auckland and Sydney with 6 hours of sunshine and a temperature which moves only 5 degrees during the day to a very desirable 21 degrees high. If you want warmer...sure you've got Brisbane but we've got the singularly prestigious bowls event of the calendar, possibly the region. The Bounty Bowls, now an open fours event, has been contested for 53 years and is as popular as ever. Now supported by stronger sponsorship and an increased ability to award attractive prizes with a minimum **prize pool of upwards of some \$9000 overall**. The main competition, the Bounty, is followed by a secondary event offering a further opportunity for putting your name up on the bowlo wall. So now we've got winter and the **TAB Triples** but we're still in our shirt sleeves....well, during the 7 hours of sunshine anyway. In the night the temp will drop by an average 5 degrees but still a darn site better than Sydney, Brisbane or Auckland and anyway the temp fall will not matter because you'll be in the clubhouse enjoying the conviviality of locals and fellow travellers; some who've returned numerous times for more. This is a long-standing popular event which has had the backing of the local TAB over some 9 years. It caters for men and ladies teams with a minimum of 5 qualifying rounds over 15 ends. It is a great leveller of the Kiwis, the Aussies and the Norfolk Islanders.

Terms and Conditions for booking with Heritage Events (HE)

Advertised prices are based on existing conditions and unless stipulated elsewhere are subject to change without notice. HE's policy is to avoid price change as far as possible and to pass on any reduction in component costs. **Confirmation of bookings** cannot occur until a non-refundable deposit of A\$150.00 (per person) is made. Final payment must be made within 3 months of proposed travel (for South Pacific Pairs by 20 October 2014, for Bounty Bowls by 01 Feb 2015, for TAB Triples by 15 May 2015). Currently there are no increases expected in the airfare component however unexpected factors may have an impact. **An air travel ticket is generally non-refundable after issue** however **changes are permitted in certain circumstances** right up to the day before you travel, however it then gets a bit sticky. Amendments, upgrades and name changes are not normally permitted within 24 hours prior to departure. Any fees arising in any of these circumstances are the responsibility of the traveller. No increases will apply once tickets have been issued. Additionally fees may apply where **cancellation of organised accommodation or other components of your travel package** occurs within 90 days of travel and can be as high as 100% of costs if cancellation occurs within 60 days. HE is unable to offer any protection against penalties of whatever form arising from cancellation of your entire travel package or part thereof. HE urges clients to **undertake suitable travel insurance**. **Payment** for part or your entire travel package can be made in one of the usual ways; by direct bank deposit, by credit card (normal surcharges will apply) or you can send us a cheque at PO Box 171 Norfolk Island. We can work out the detail by email. Any **advertised bonuses, awards or promotions** are secured only on payment of the deposit required to confirm a booking. **Meal vouchers** supplied as part of package are recoverable at Mariah's Ocean View Restaurant and are non-transferable. They can be used throughout a bowls event at lunch or dinner sittings only, to the benefit only of the holder. They cease to have effect upon departure of the holder from Norfolk Island. **Special conditions apply to Bounty Bowls Sponsors Prize. Eligibility** is restricted to HE clients who have purchased a travel package through HE. The 2015 **prizes are at two levels**. Subject to eligibility, the first being available at advertised amounts to the winning Bounty Fours team and the second being available at advertised amounts to the 2nd-placed Bounty Fours team. The value of each **prize is shared equally** among the winners or runner-ups and, subject to the following, **a share is not transferable**. In the event that a prize-winning team is **comprised partly of persons residing ordinarily in Norfolk Island** and partly of HE clients then those persons residing ordinarily in Norfolk Island retain an ability to dispose of a winning share at 50% of face value. There are **no other circumstances** whereby any eligibility under these arrangements accrues to persons residing ordinarily on Norfolk Island. The **quantum of each prize** will be available as a deduction from the total travel package for ANY Norfolk Island bowls event in the ensuing year, booking through HE and staying at Heritage Hill Hotel.
